- Describe the day you were baptized. What details do you know about the day? What is your Baptism birthday? Who are your godparents? What is necessary for a Baptism ceremony? Why?
- Today is Reformation Sunday. What did Martin Luther teach about Baptism?
 Who is doing the work in Baptism—the person receiving the Sacrament or the Holy Spirit?
